## East Suffolk and North Essex NHS Foundation Trust is the largest NHS organisation in the region and provides services from Colchester and lpswich hospitals, as well as a number of community sites.

Elis has been providing the Trust with linen rental for the past decade, including a fully-managed on-site service at Colchester Hospital, where it has more recently also started supplying reusable surgical gowns.

As part of the service, Elis had previously been delivering flat linen direct to the Trust's community sites. However, following extensive analysis, the company identified that cost savings could be achieved by switching to bulk delivery of community sites' stock to Ipswich Hospital.

The contract is serviced by Elis's Dartford site, which produces a variety of monthly reports, including monthly and yearly spend and usage comparisons, top 15 products, pieces per bed analysis and benchmarking to other sites. From this reporting it was identified that savings could be made by switching to direct delivery to Ipswich with pack to ward, and this change has now been implemented.
